Voicemail Set Up and Use:

Setting up your new mailbox

- 1. Press the voicemail button on your phone or dial *95 and pickup your receiver.
- 2. When prompted, enter your password and #. (default 1234#)
- 3. Press 0 for mailbox setup.

Press 1 to record your unavailable greeting.

Press 2 to record your busy greeting.

Press 3 to record your name.

Press 4 to add a temporary (vacation greeting).

Press 5 to change your password.

Note: When you've recorded a greeting, press # for continuing prompts and the prompt to save your new greeting.

If you're assigned a 'virtual' mailbox

- 1. Dial your virtual mailbox number from any system extension
- 2. When your current greeting begins playing, press *.
- 3. Enter your password when prompted (1234#) and press 0 for mailbox setup.

Press 1 to record your no answer greeting.

Press 2 to record your busy greeting.

Press 3 to record your name.

Press 4 to add a temporary (vacation greeting).

Press 5 to change your password.

Note: When you've recorded a greeting, press # for continuing prompts and the prompt to save your new greeting.

New messages

Your voicemail light will be lit when there is a new message on your extension.

- 1. Press the voicemail button on your phone or dial *95 and pickup your receiver.
- 2. When prompted, enter your password and #. (default 1234#)
- 3. Press 1 for new messages.
- 4. Pressing 7 deletes the current message.

Tips

To skip the prompted reading of the date/time/callerID stamp of the message, press 1.

To skip to the next message, press 6.

To return to the beginning of a voicemail, press #.

How to check your voicemail from another extension

- ${\bf 1.}\ {\bf Dial}\ {\bf your}\ {\bf extension}\ {\bf number}\ {\bf from}\ {\bf another}\ {\bf extension}.$
- 2. After your extension is finished ringing, it will send you to voicemail.
- 3. Once you hear you own "unavailable" message, immediately press the * button
- 4. You will hear "This is the voicemail system" and you will be prompted to enter your password.
- 5. Please follow the prompts to listen to your message or messages.

How to check your voicemail from outside the system

- 1. Please dial your main office phone number.
 - a. If your call is answered by an auto attendant, please enter your extension number.
 - b. If your call is answered by a receptionist, please ask them to transfer you to your extension number.
- 2. After your extension is finished ringing, it will send you to voicemail.
- 3. Once you hear you own "unavailable" message, immediately press the * button
- 4. You will hear "This is the voicemail system" and you will be prompted to enter your password.
- 5. Please follow the prompts to listen to your message or messages.
